Expansion BOSC by Made Studio

A tribute to the popular wicker grid

New dining environment, single and double sun loungers, and lighting solutions

Bosc, the collection presented in 2020 in collaboration with Made Studio, pays tribute to the popular **wicker grid**, a material with a strong presence in traditional artisan furniture, used mainly in the making of seats, backs and fronts of multiple furniture. Its hypnotic framework favors ventilation, while its flexibility provides ergonomics and allows curved formats. With **Bosc**, Made Studio transfers both its aesthetics and these attributes to a **micro-perforated aluminum sheet** with a weave that seeks to reproduce the fabric of these grids using semi-industrial methods, but made of a material suitable for an outdoor location. The result is moving, as its execution is truly faithful.

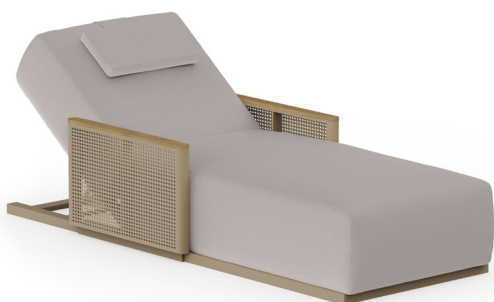
Initially integrated by seats and low tables to project outdoor living rooms, the **Bosc** collection is now expanded by incorporating an **extendable dining table and its chair**, a **single and a double sun lounger**, as well as an environmental element that works both as a **lamp and side table**, whose rounded design further alludes to the versatility of the grid for curved shapes. 2 New solutions designed by Borja García and Laura Ros, co-founders of Made Studio, to complete the existing lounge area elements.

*"The leap of **Bosc** from the lounge area to the dining area, with outdoor dining solutions, allows a space to be resolved with a **single collection**, but with enough differences between the pieces to avoid monotony and excessive homogeneity", apuntan desde **Made Studio**.*

With up to 360 cm long, the **rectangular table** of **Bosc** stands out for its resounding character and for the generous dimensions that it can reach. For their part, the **chairs, sun loungers and Bosc lamps** have been resolved with the pattern of micro-perforated aluminum sheet distinctive of the series, joined to **certain details in iroko**, in the armrests or in the tops, that give them warmth. In the case of the **Bosc lamps**, this wood has been used to achieve its **double function** as a lantern and side table. In the sun loungers, voluminous upholstered elements have been chosen to provide the greatest comfort.

All the elements of the **Bosc** collection are distinguished by their commitment to durability and **sustainability**. *"The structures are made with 100% recyclable aluminum and FSC wood 1 from controlled sources. In addition, all its components are fully suitable for outdoor use, from its technical fabrics and recycled PET to the last screw. All of this makes Bosc furniture more durable, less 1 perishable and, therefore, much more sustainable from the beginning to the end of its useful life,"* highlight from Made Studio.

Bosc is a collection of designs conceived from the comfort and adaptability of **Mediterranean architecture**, with the purpose of being versatile by fitting into all types of environments and outdoor spaces, both residential and **contract**, and even indoors.

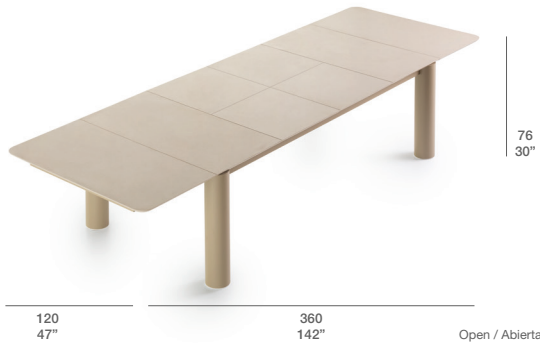

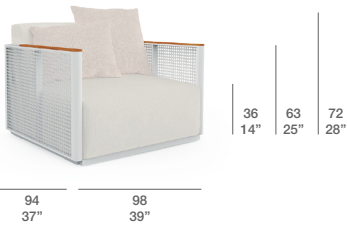

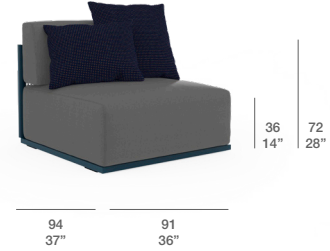
