This feature not only enhances the practicality of the space, but also contributes to the creation of a cozy and functional environment in various lighting conditions.

Once again, the **DAYBED 4.0** cushions and mats are filled with recyclable polyurethane foam rubber covered with water-repellent fabric. The outdoor upholstery is removable and available in GANDIABLASCO's wide selection of finishes and colors, including technical outdoor fabrics from Kvadrat, Sunbrella and Dedar Milano, among others, as well as fabrics made from 100% recycled and recyclable PET from Reviva.

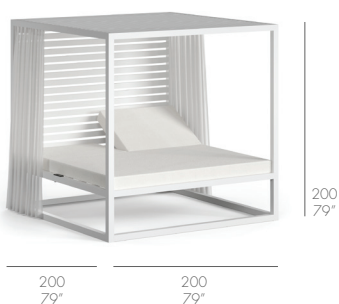


## José A. Gandía-Blasco Canales:
